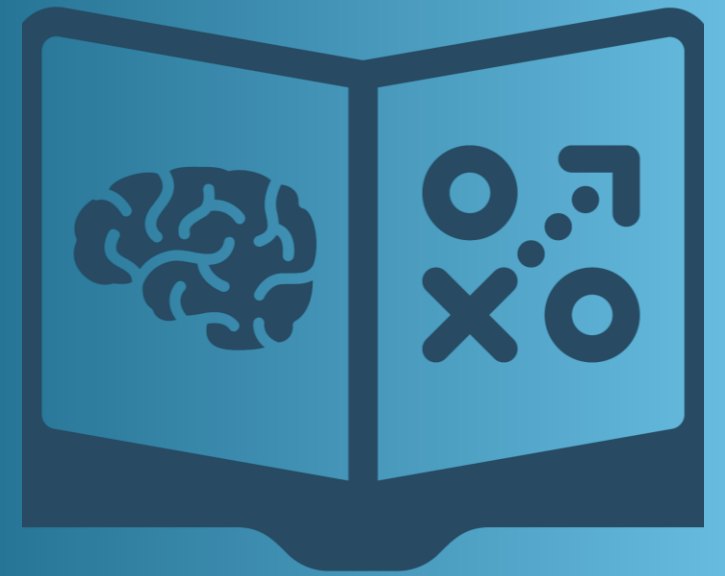




Co-design a Team-based Behavioral Interventions Playbook with rehabilitation team members, persons with brain injury and family members/care partners

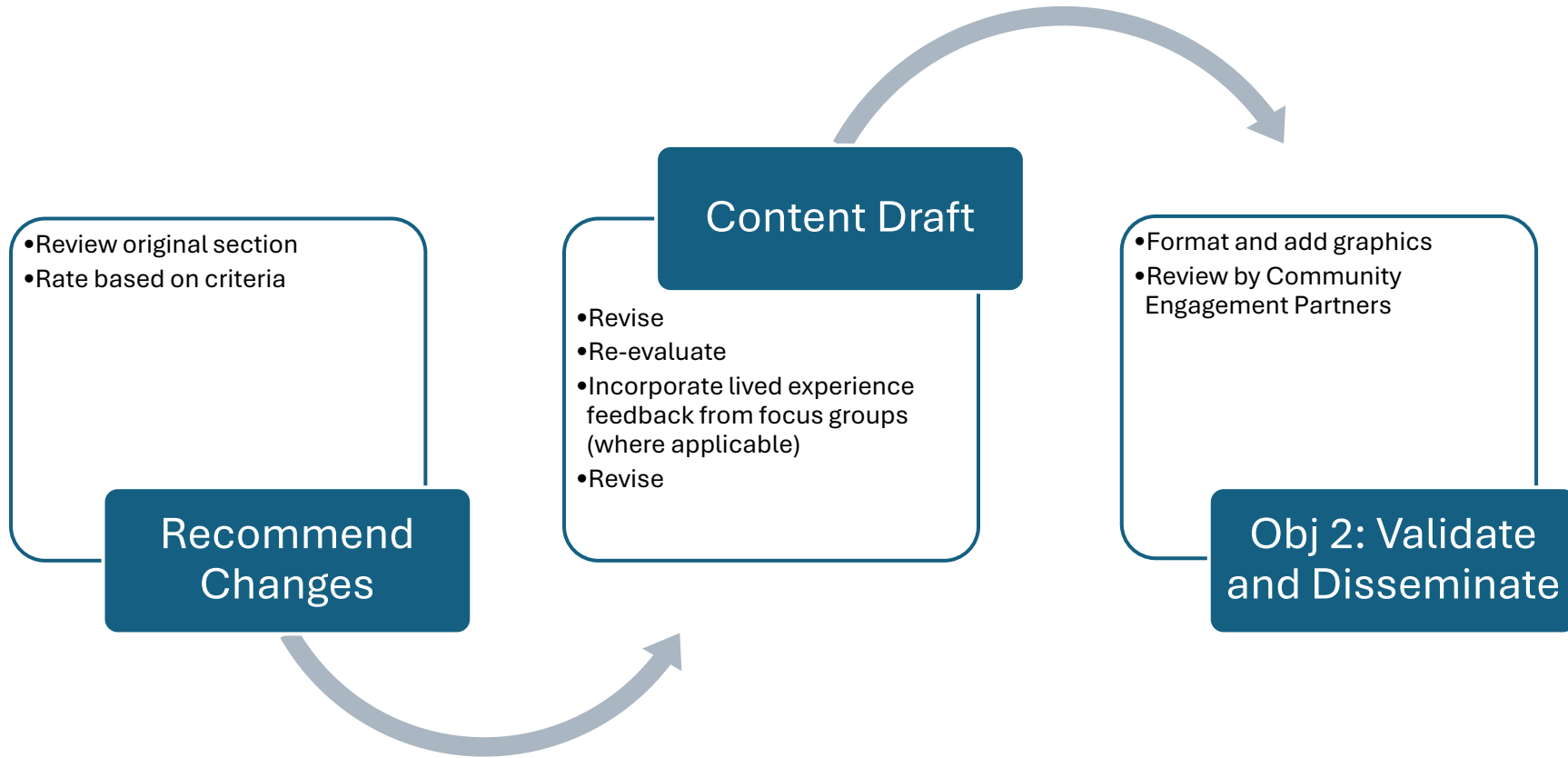


Patients and families will provide their perspectives on experiences in rehabilitation relative to addressing challenging behavior.

Rehab professionals will identify the modifications and additions needed to transform the STAR-VA manual into a TeamBI Playbook.

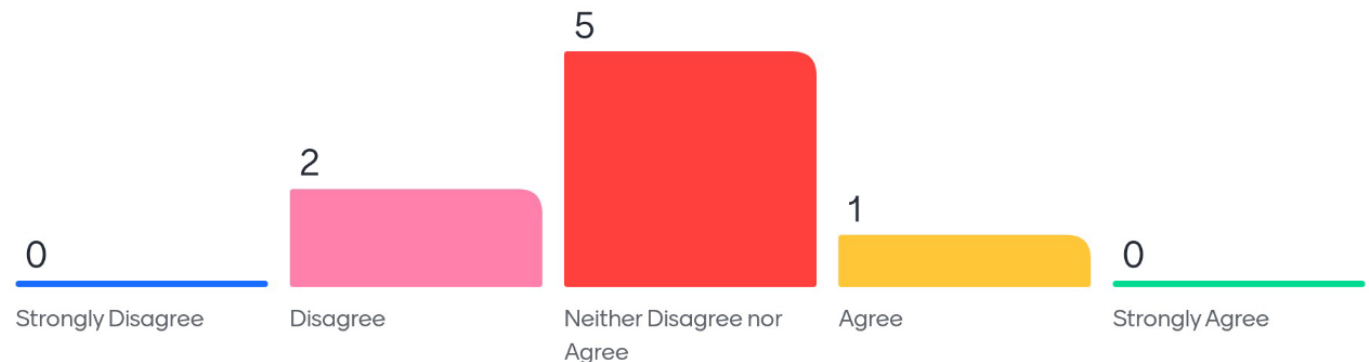
Rehab Professional (IEP) Workgroup: Process



Criteria for StarVA Review

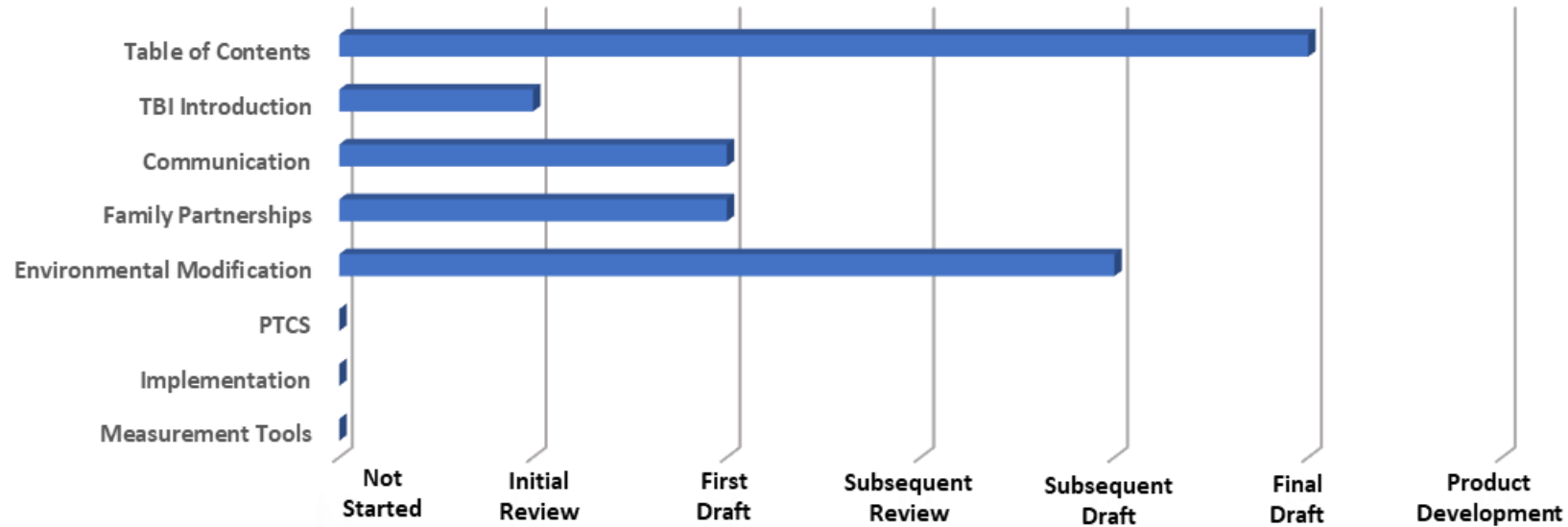
- The information presented represents current evidence-based practice.

- USF has approved protocol. OSU IRB is currently reviewing.
